- The Gulf STUDY is now the largest and most comprehensive oil spill health study ever conducted. More than 32,000 participants completed an enrollment interview and over 11,000 completed a home exam.
- We have collected valuable information that will help answer questions about the short-term health effects of the spill. Later this year, we hope to release findings from the enrollment interview and home exam related to symptoms and mental health.
- We are already learning about ongoing health effects. More than 16,000 participants have completed their first follow-up telephone interview.
- We will learn even more from upcoming clinical visits. About 6,500 participants will be invited to visit one of our study clinics for more advanced testing of lung and nervous system function and other procedures.
